DIVISION I: Purebred Sheep

- Animals one year or over must have proper proof of registration, while animals under one year of age must be eligible for registration. All papers will be checked at time of registration.
- All purebred sheep must bear breeder's flock number tags.
- All sheep must be clean and free of signs of disease.
- There will be classes for all breeds of sheep, however there must be four sheep entered in a breed to justify selecting a Champion or Reserve Champion. If less than four sheep: all ewes will show in one class and all rams in one class. Class premiums will be awarded.

- An exhibitor may show a maximum of four singles in the market lamb show.
- All lambs presented to show must be free from contagious and infectious diseases.
- The judge's decisions are final.
